Early Head Start

Now Enrolling Infants, Toddlers & Expectant Mothers!



We offer two program options:

Home Based: Families receive a weekly home visit from a specially trained home visitor who brings activities and materials to promote the child's development, health, and nutrition. Families also attend two play group sessions each month, for social interaction.

Center Based: Three degreed teachers provide caring, consistent and individualized child care in a multi-aged classroom of only eight children. This option is for parents who are working or attending school.

EARLY HEAD START PARTICIPANTS RECEIVE:

- Personalized support from caring early childhood experts
- Prenatal education for expectant mothers
- Screenings of the child's health, development, hearing, and vision
- Individualized activities to encourage each child's development
- Referrals to community services to meet each family's needs
- Resources to ensure your child's health, safety, and good nutrition
- Special services for children with special needs
- Support for parents as the most important teacher in a child's life
