**HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (HEAP)
CONTINUES**

The current economic conditions have created more hardship for many low-income seniors and families who struggle to pay their energy bills. Warren County Community Services, Inc. (WCCS) Emergency HEAP Winter Crisis Program is still providing Warren County residents assistance with heating needs.

If you or someone you know are facing a utility disconnection or have less than a 10-day supply of bulk fuel, please contact WCCS HEAP.

In addition to other eligibility requirements, a “household income” level cannot exceed 175% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

Here are the Current Income Guidelines based on gross income:

Size of household	Quarterly	Annual
1 person.....	\$4,550	\$18,200
2 persons.....	\$6,125	\$24,500
3 persons.....	\$7,700	\$30,800
4 persons.....	\$9,275	\$37,100
5 persons.....	\$10,850	\$43,400
6 persons.....	\$12,425	\$49,700
7 persons.....	\$14,000	\$56,000
