

Winter Crisis Program starts November 1, 2017



If you are a low-income household facing disconnection of your primary or secondary heating source, have already had service disconnected, or have less than 25% supply of bulk fuel/propane; please contact Warren County Community Services (WCCS) HEAP office immediately for assistance. The HEAP Winter Crisis Program, is a federally funded program administered by WCCS, will be accepting applications starting November 1, 2017. Households with incomes at or below 175% of the 2017 Federal Poverty Guidelines may apply, see below:
