RSVP MISSION STATEMENT

RSVP enriches the lives of men and women, age 55 and over, through meaningful volunteer opportunities that use their time and abilities to address critical community needs in Warren County.

GENERAL BACKGROUND

Warren County RSVP was established in 1974. Volunteers choose how, where, and how often they want to serve, with commitments ranging from a few hours to 40 hours per week.

EXAMPLES OF RSVP VOLUNTEER SERVICE

- Forty RSVP volunteers gave 5,157 hours of service to local food pantries that assisted approximately 16,123 Warren County individuals in need of emergency food assistance.
- Twenty-four RSVP volunteers provided 1,220 terminally ill patients support services at The Hospice of Butler & Warren Counties.
- Twenty RSVP volunteers gave 1,083 hours tutoring approximately 46 adults to help improve their overall reading skills or receive their GEDs.
- Twenty-four RSVP volunteers served a total of 5,485 hours at three Warren County thrift shops that assisted over 2,700 individuals with food, rent, utilities, prescriptions and other needs.
