Helping Children and Families Succeed

Early Learning Centers

Gives all children an opportunity for high quality childhood education. A generous teacher to child ratio (1:6) for preschool and (3:8) for infants and toddlers at nationally accredited and star-rated centers prepare children for success in school. Childcare options are available.

Family Services

Provides support and information to families who are experiencing difficulty meeting their essential needs. Services include:

- Medication Assistance Program (MAP)
- Success Toward Employment Program (STEP)
- Temporary Emergency Financial Assistance



Helping Reduce Energy Costs

Emergency Home Energy Assistance Program (E-HEAP)

Assists income-eligible households with energy needs by providing financial assistance through programs like Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP), Winter Crisis (WCP) and Summer Cooling (SCP).

Housing for Seniors & Families

Balanced Housing

Assists homeowners with maintaining homeownership and potential homebuyers achieve homeownership through education programs and confidential counseling services. Low- or no-down payment loan programs, credit repair, housing repair and development are also provided.

Affordable Housing

Provides and operates beautiful, clean, safe, and affordable housing for families and seniors in Warren County.



Helping Older Adults Remain Active and Independent

The 741 Center

Offers adults, 50 and over, an array of quality programs, services, activities, trips and information to enrich their lives. The Center provides a relaxed, welcoming atmosphere to offer new experiences, make friends, and enjoy a healthy lunch.

Meals on Wheels™ and Senior Dining Centers

Delivers fresh, nutritionally balanced lunches to homebound adults, 60 and over. Trained and caring drivers, who also provide a safety check for WCCS clients, deliver meals Monday through Friday. Weekend meals are also available. Hot, prepared fresh daily lunches are also served at several dining centers throughout the county.

Supportive Services

Provides adults, 60 and over, individualized assistance with applications and insurance. Links clients to benefits and services including prescription programs.

RSVP Volunteer Program

Assists individuals, age 55 and over, in exploring their volunteer interests. The program strives to deliver a high quality volunteer experience and focuses volunteers on meeting community needs.

Senior Transportation

Provides assisted medical and non-medical transportation to seniors, 60 and over. Medical transportation is within Warren County and all surrounding counties. Nonmedical transportation is for groups of 4 or more, picked up from the same location, going to the same destination, typically within Warren County.

Elderly Services Program (ESP)

Assesses and provides support services to older adults, age 60 and over, to help them remain safe and independent in their own homes. WCCS provides the Intake, Assessment and Care Management services for Warren County Elderly Services Program.
