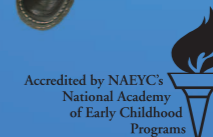

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

- Bus transportation provided for most areas.
- Early Head Start offers home-based education and family support services from birth to 3 years.*
- Full-day, year-round child care and early education provided for ages 3 to 5.
- Nutritious, home-cooked, hot meals and snacks provided.
- Part-day early education program (preschool) available.*
- Special services are provided for children with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) from child’s local school district.
- Spanish enrichment.

ENROLLMENT GUIDELINES

- Infants and toddlers (Birth – 3 years old) may be eligible for the Early Head Start Program options.
- Children (ages 3 to 5 years old) may enroll in either the full-day education/child care or the part-day preschool option.
- Children who are still being toilet trained are accepted in preschool.
- Children with disabilities are welcome.

* Some program options – Early Head Start (Home Visits and Center Based Care) and Part-Day Preschool – are available primarily to families who meet income guidelines. However, other child and family needs are taken into consideration. Please talk with WCCS about these options. WCCS wants to help meet your family’s needs.
