



THERAPEUTIC INTERAGENCY PRESCHOOL (TIP PROGRAM)

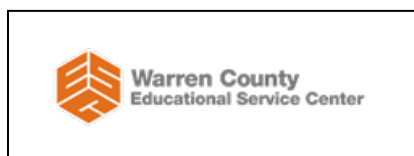
The Warren County TIP Program is now accepting referrals.

TIP is a collaboratively funded program between **WCCS Early Learning Centers**, **Warren County Children Services**, & **the Warren County Educational Service Center**. Medicaid reimbursed transportation arranged by Warren County Job and Family Services. TIP is designed to serve Head Start eligible preschool age children who have experienced trauma. Children and their families receive supportive & integrated educational and mental health interventions. The goals are to increase child resiliency and promote healthy social interactions which are central to facilitating school readiness for preschoolers effected by trauma.
