Since 1966, Warren County Community Services, Inc. has been the primary regional social services link for Warren County residents.

A nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization, WCCS is the largest and most comprehensive nonprofit, charitable social service agency in the area — connecting people to the resources necessary to realize their full potential for a quality life.



WCCS receives funding from many organizations including the Council on Aging of SW Ohio, U.S. Dept. of Health and Human Services, Ohio Dept. of Education, Ohio Development Services Agency, and AmeriCorps.



Early Learning Centers

Early Learning Centers

We offer high-quality, early childhood education for infants, toddlers, and preschool children at gold-star rated centers that prepare children for success in school. Part-day and full-day Head Start (3–5 yrs), full-day and home-based Early Head Start (0-3 yrs), and childcare options are all available.

Literacy Connections

We provide trained volunteers to tutor adults on literacy skills and teach legal immigrants English, so they may work and live productively in the community. Students may also receive assistance preparing for citizenship and GED testing.

For Household Needs

Energy Assistance (HEAP)

We offer financial assistance for energy bills for income-eligible households through programs like Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP), Winter Crisis (WCP), and Summer Cooling (SCP).

Emergency Services

We help income-qualified Warren County residents who are experiencing sudden hardship. We can assist with emergency financial assistance for rent and utilities to solve immediate, urgent, and short-term needs. Customers also receive case management services to address each unique situation.

For Housing Needs

Affordable Housing

We provide clean, affordable housing for income-eligible Warren County families and adults age 62+. Ten senior housing developments and one family housing development offer a safe, well-maintained environment for qualified residents.

For The Community

Community Assistance

Our Community Assistance team works closely with individuals and families to find long-term solutions and build a path toward lasting stability. We support households with financial assistance tailored to their needs and available funds.

For Older Adults

The 741 Center

We offer a center for adults age 50+ to experience an array of life-enriching activities such as SilverSneakers, games, crafts, informational classes, and trips. The Center provides a fun, welcoming, and relaxed atmosphere to enjoy new experiences, make friends, and enjoy a healthy lunch.

Meals on Wheels™ and Senior Dining Centers

We deliver fresh, nutritionally-balanced meals to adults 60+ in Warren and Butler Counties. Meals are delivered Monday through Friday to extend seniors independence and good health as they age. Freshly-prepared daily lunches are also served at several dining centers throughout Warren County.

Supportive Services

We connect adults age 60+ to a wide variety of services and we assist with applications for benefits such as Medicaid/Medicare, monthly commodity boxes, energy assistance, and home modification grants. Light errands and social visits are also available to homebound individuals. Some programs are based on income eligibility.

RSVP Volunteer Program

We utilize the talents and skills of individuals 55+ to strengthen the community through rewarding volunteer opportunities. Volunteers choose where and when to serve and how much time to give.

Senior Transportation

We provide medical and nonmedical transportation to adults, 60+. Medical transportation is provided within Warren County and all surrounding counties. Nonmedical transportation is for groups of three or more, from the same location to the same destination, typically within Warren County.

Care Management

We provide Intake and Care Management for Warren County adults 60+ who meet eligibility criteria and qualify for services to help them remain independent in their own homes.
