We enroll children based on the following guidelines:

- Income-based
- Public Assistance: Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Foster care, kinship or homelessness qualify
- Children with disabilities are welcome
- Children who are still being toilet trained are accepted in preschool
- No cost to families who qualify for Head Start (part-day preschool program)
- Child Care Assistance accepted for full-day programs
